Dr. Thomas “Danny” Boston is a Professor of Economics and International Affairs at Georgia Tech, where he specializes in minority and small business analysis, economic development (focused on Africa) and low-income housing and community development. Professor Boston is also a successful entrepreneur and CEO of EuQuant, an economic research and urban planning company. In 2016, the Atlanta Business League selected him “Entrepreneur of the Year”.

A native of Jacksonville, Florida, he received his BS Degree from West Virginia State University and a Ph.D. Degree in Economics from Cornell University.

Dr. Boston has served as Senior Economist to the Joint Economic Committee of Congress, Chairman of the Department of Economics at Clark-Atlanta University and past President of the National Economic Association. He is the author or editor of six books and numerous scholar articles. He testifies regularly before committees of the US Congress and has served as economics contributor to CNN.

Professor Boston is a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity and recipient of numerous prestigious awards while at Tech; including, “Undergraduate Professor of the Year”, “Ivan Allen College Legacy Award”, and the State of Georgia “Economics Educator of the Year” award. He received the Purple Heart while serving as an infantry officer in the US Army.

He has two children, Linje and Shani, and his wife, Dr Catherine Ross, is the Harry West Professor of City and Regional Planning at Georgia Tech.
